Interview with Michael Lucy, Senior Consultant of Stewardship and Planning at the Anacostia Watershed Society.

Michael is an interesting interview subject because he works for the Anacostia Watershed Society, which is responsible for helping to fund the installation of more than 60,000 s.f. of new green roofs around the DC area. The Anacostia Watershed Society has helped put green roofs up at the World Wildlife Fund, which is rumored to have the largest in the city, American Chemical Society, and American University, among others. We'll be filming at the District Department of the Environment's green roof, which is an organization that works with the Anacostia Watershed Society on the green roof program.

Michael administers the Green Roof Rebate Program and works on environmental site design and low impact development projects around the area. He has more than 20 years of experience in environmental design, development, construction, and management.
